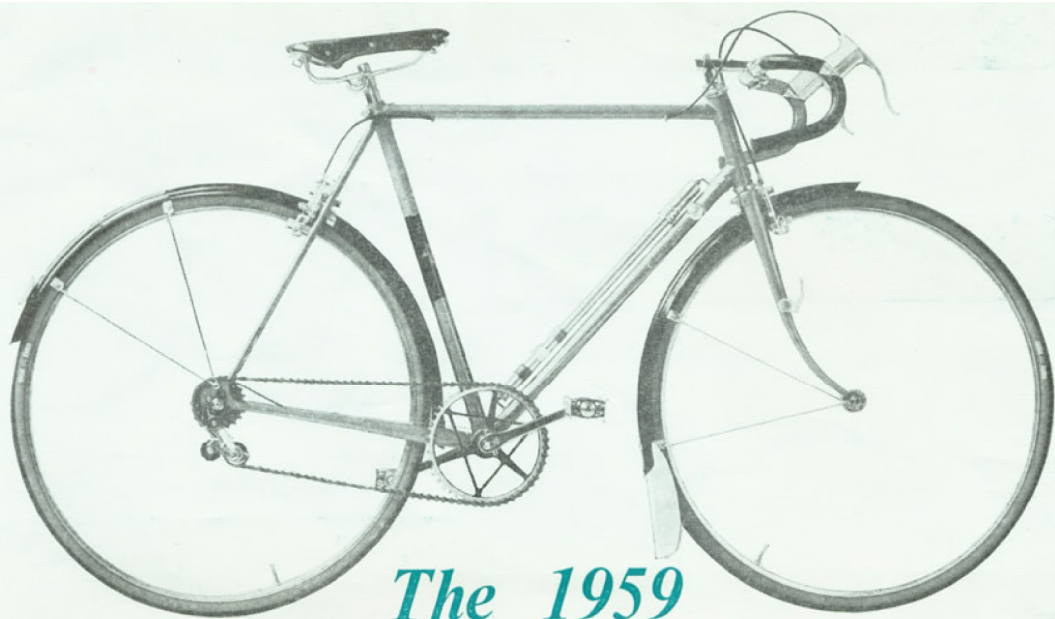

The OLYMPIC

Road-Path

Built particularly for the man who likes to mix short distance road work with pursuits and grass track riding.

This frame has 73° parallel angles, round fork blades and very rigid rear triangle. Reynolds famous "531" tubing is brazed into Continental lugs and solid cast fork crown, drilled for a shallow brake. Sturdy long slot path ends are fitted, allowing a choice of gears without constant alteration of chain length which is difficult when using 1" pitch. No lamp bracket boss or pump pegs are fitted and this, combined with bare mudguard clearance, gives a "clean look" when on the track. The ideal frame for riding down to an "under-the-hour" or track event.

All lugs lined and top eyes and crown picked out by hand.

Contrasting transfer bands and Signature etc. as Cordon Bleu.

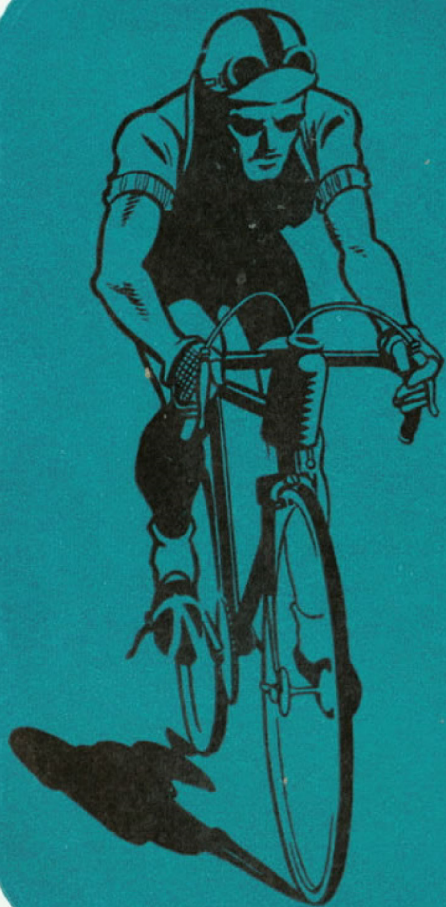

Road racing frame 'par excellence'

Designed from the experience of leading exponents of the massed start game both on the Continent and in Great Britain. The result is a frame which can be relied upon to give stability combined with response to every effort made by the rider striving towards "International" status.

Constructed from Reynolds "531" double-buttet High Carbon Steel tubing, finest Continental lugs by Nervex, angles 72° parallel. Wrap-over top eyes with Agrati ends and oval to round chain stays give a solid back, which is balanced by a lower than normal bottom bracket. Fork blades of finely tapered oval section are set into a sturdy crown. All usual brake and gear cable eyes are fitted. NO pump pegs or lamp bracket boss are fitted.

FINISH. Any colour Flamboyant, Lustre or Hard-wearing Enamel to choice. The top eyes, crown and lug profiles carefully picked out by hand and contrasting bands on seat tube. Metal Head plate and Transfer Crest with Script Signature plus Model name on top tube give the final smart "touch."
