Sizes of frames are restricted to those shown only so that the general design shall be reconciled, broadly speaking, to coincide with the rider's height, inside leg measurement and reach.

" SPECIALS "

Full scale drawing (at nominal cost of £1 ls. 0d.) may be forwarded to rider for approval on request if special frame design submitted for estimate makes this necessary.

VARIATIONS ON MODELS

If so desired frames may be interchanged between models, so that, for instance, "Brevit Club" can be supplied with "Super Velo" completion parts (or vice versa), price being adjusted according to the difference in frame prices (purchase tax being calculated at the rate of 4s. 8d. in the £).

CARRIAGE IS FREE

Cycles, tandems and frames are despatched carriage paid to destinations within Great Britain and Northern Ireland, and are insured against damage in transit. In the event of damage or loss it is essential that carriers are notified immediately and the relative insurance coupons (enclosed with postal advice) returned to Claud Butler at once.
