Interest on the balance is charged at the rate of 10% for 12 monthly payments, and a rebate of half this interest will be given if the transaction is completed by six monthly payments, the first instalment being due one month after receipt of machine.

The terms for the new Twickenham Model are £1 deposit with order, balance to be paid by twelve monthly payments of 13/- each. Extras to be paid for with deposit.
